**CHAMPIONSHIP RULES** – Will shortly be updated and available on the Eastern ACU website. Please note minor changes around points scoring (8C) and lights (5). Championship points will not be scored in the final round if no points have been scored in preceding rounds. Lights are required at solo events, they are not required at Two Man events. The rules now incorporate a specific penalty for non compliance.

**PROVISION OF RIDER NUMBERS/BACKGROUNDS** – Phil Roper of Indigo Ross has generously offered to produce sets of standardized numbers incorporating event sponsor logos for 2023. We plan to be in a position to use these at events in 2023, though it may not apply to all events. Diss MCC expressed some concerns regarding the practicality of these numbers at the Santon and Muntjac events. Neil S to speak with Phil Roper regarding wording. The word "centre" is not to be used on the design. Neil S and Deb H to confirm detail of number splits etc. for printing purposes.

**SPORT 80 MANAGEMENT SYSTEM** – There was a useful discussion around the proposed system. We await developments on implementation. It was highlighted that costs of operation to clubs will increase.

**YOUTH CLASS** – Sudbury MCC have led the way on a Youth class which has run alongside their adult events. They are keen to expand the opportunities for the Youth class and the other event organisers were asked to consider if a youth class can be run at their events.

**TIMING SYSTEM/TRANSPONDERS** – With the help of Don Blackman and Richard Snowden we are looking at a way of having a transponder based timing system which can be used by all event organizing clubs, and which will be a standard system across all our events. BUT...we need more people to be volunteers to run the system. With 13 events across 9 months of the season the commitment is too big for one person.

We will make an appeal via the Eastern ACU Enduro Facebook page and at the forum for help with running the timing system.
