Sad Passing of Bob Drane

Few people exemplified as distinctly the dual roles of successful trials rider and steadfast club member as Braintree's Bob Drane, who passed away at the turn of the year. Bob had reached a very good age, it is thought well into his nineties and had been a leading Eastern Centre trials rider since the 1950's - being notable for the peculiar rounded tank on his Greeves and his ear-flapped riding hat - helmets not being compulsory in those years.

Not quite a founding member when the Braintree club joined the reformed Eastern Centre in 1946, Bob was nonetheless one of the longest serving members, which the club recognised many years ago in making him a lifelong member at a special gathering for that purpose.

Bob had followed motorcycle sport for many years, and before actively competing, attended many of the frequent scrambles in this region as well as going long distances in organised coach-loads to Championship and International meetings such as those held in Shropshire at Hawkstone Park. In his own competitive riding, Bob was a "thinker" in terms of trials performances, taking his own time when confronted by a section and working out carefully what would be the best line to take. This aspect reflected his working career as a skilled machinist who produced very precise prototypes of equipment in early research stage - on occasion for Her Majesty's government. (as then)



In his later career, Bob used both his riding skills and his ability to read information and data to follow and open up the numerous "green lanes" in the Braintree area and would take a party of fellow riders along with him - under strict discipline to observe due courtesy to horse riders and walkers. The event became popular and was invariably prefaced by dinner at the Andrews field (Stebbing) airfield. He worked for the Eastern Centre as: "Rights-of-way" delegate for many years and in his methodical way, joined and became a worthy and well regarded delegate on the Essex County Council's: 'Footpaths and Rights of Way' committee.

A quietly spoken, very courteous character, Bob nonetheless had decided and sometimes strongly expressed views and was a stout defender of our sport, if not always in favour of the way it is run. He was nonetheless a loyal club and Centre man and both will miss him - and I suspect, some of the values he stood for.

2024 ACU Eastern Youth Trials Championship

Clive Dopson - Secretary to the ACU-EC Trials Committee

At the 2023 ACU-EC Trials Forum on November 1st it was decided that for 2024 the Youth Championship classes within B Class rounds will remain as 2023, that is Youth Expert, Intermediate and Novice. Where a club organising a B Class round can offer a beginner's route (lower than white) there will also be a new Youth Beginner class. In addition, all clubs, where a beginner's route is included, were offered to host a round of the Youth Beginner's Championship. Championship points will be calculated but there will not be a Youth Beginners trophy in 2024. Once a rider has ridden as Youth Novice or above, they cannot score points as Youth Beginner. All youth classes remain open to all ages of youth rider's dependant on parents or guardians ensuring they are capable of riding the class entered. The 2024 Youth ACU-EC Championship Trials are as the table below, the championship will be reviewed at the 2024 Trials Forum, probably in early November.

Recollection Section

Sidge Kenny



We've all come across a colleague or a chum who is a bit hard on all things mechanical. He is the one that whacks items a bit too enthusiastically with his hammer, or yanks too vigorously on a cable and inevitably he is the one who tightens up his nuts with cruel ferocity. And usually, he is the one we have to eventually sort out and repair his mechanical wrong-doing.

More than often however, he is also the one with, in every other aspect, a sensible and genuinely thoughtful, friendly personality.

As a result you – being equally such a kindly friend - spend much of your spare time getting him out of a muddle. I speak of such things from first hand experience. My friend, Ollie, is such a (rather lovable) case.

I have lost count of the number of times I have had to “nip round” and sort out his various tales of woe – mainly all self-induced. The split alloy cases, stripped threads, bruised shafts and ruined oil seals give evidence of a man who should rather be collecting cheese labels. Yet with great good humour and almost infectious confidence, Ollie undertakes his work. Rarely am I called in before the disaster to give any advice or at least, a second opinion. Ollie sails in – literally, just like a novice explorer in the jungle who sets off merrily into the wilderness, without a care in the world or without snake-proof boots – or even his phone.

Motorcycling as a rule brings with it the need to adopt a degree of mechanical prowess and in years past, most riders would take great pride in the knowledge that their machines rarely, if ever, had to go to a repair shop. They maintained them as well as riding them – which endowed the rider with several talents from mending punctures to complete rebuilding of engines and gearboxes. Talent and skill was thereby a dividend gained – though perhaps in this day and age not quite so deeply rooted as in the past. The bikes nowadays especially in the electronic department, are more sophisticated, need highly specialised gear to find out what is wrong – it is (so they say!) a by-product of progress.

In the competition field however, and at the lower “clubmen” level, most riders are indeed talented mechanics and religiously maintain their bikes to produce good performance.

Further, so many embark on making up complete bikes and devising previously unheard-of mixtures of engines and frames – if they are not fully: “home-built.” This advanced factor is one that I particularly admire. The satisfaction from riding a bike in any type of discipline which you have constructed, must give enormous pleasure – regardless of how you actually did in the event. It is a talent which sadly I do not possess though I can keep most things running – and wearily, I am clearly just of adequate prowess to help Ollie get out of the s**t - or more politely - the mechanical mire.

Alan Cocksedge Photos of Eastern Centre Events Pt. 6

In this addition of the Gazette are Alan Cocksedge colour photos from 1962 in fact 1st April and again the then named Sudbury & District Motor Cycle & Light Car Club Scramble at Tye Farm Great Cornard. This was the Club's second Scramble in its history, Barry Chaplin now 19 was again Secretary of the Meeting plus Clerk of the Course as Don 'Tubber' King had stepped back on his position on the Committee. Barry names the event 'Suffolk Point-to-Point Scramble' and set about getting some of the top country's riders, first he got the 'local boy' Dave Bickers undefeated 250cc European Motorcross Champion next Barry went after the other top British rider Jeff Smith who had won 4 British Titles and went on to win another 5 plus two World Championship Titles. It was a bit of a cat and mouse game but Barry was determined and he snared his prey.

I took over from 'Tubber' as Press Secretary in 1962 I was 16 and here came Alan Cocksedge into the picture. I was asked to go and see him at the Suffolk Free Press offices in Sudbury which was close to my place of work. He explained the Scramble needed publicity and he gave me a piece he had written and a list of media outlets that this press release should go to – WOW – there were nearly 40 included in the list were all the local newspapers in East Anglia, three national newspapers, the Motor Cycle press plus two Television companies, there was Anglia in Norwich which started in 1959 and the local BBC also in Norwich plus BBC Sports View in London which went out nationally. I had learnt to type so one evening I borrowed a portable typewriter from work, obtained some carbon paper typed out on the Club's headed notepaper 40 copies actually 5 sheets 8 times. WOW what affect these press releases had nearly 9,000 spectators turned up on the day some as far as Oxfordshire

Jeff Smith won 3 races, W J A Mills the Juniors, Dave Bickers up to 350cc and Jim Aim was the only finisher of the Veteran Bike race. Both Anglia & BBC local showed footage on the Monday night. The Final Account Book shows Income £394/17/6 Expenditure £218/6/6 Profit £176/11/0.
