2024 ACU Eastern Solo Youth Enduro Championship

1. Events

All ACU Eastern Youth events will be run under Short Course or Hare & Hounds regulations as per the ACU Handbook. They shall run as support events to selected ACU Eastern Solo and Two Man events.

2. Eligibility

Open to Youth Riders aged 12 to 16 competing in the non-adult separate 'youth' event. Youth riders aged 14 to 16 inclusive competing in Adult events will not be eligible to compete in this championship.

3. Classes and machine capacities

Classes and machine capacities as per the ACU Hare and Hounds Regulations.

4. Calculation of championship points

For each event the calculation of points for overall and all classes will be as follows:

6th 10 points	11th 5 points
7th 9 points	12th 4 points
8th 8 points	13th 3 points
9th 7 points	14th 2 points
10th 6 points	15th 1 point
	7th 9 points 8th 8 points 9th 7 points

In the case of ties in the results of each day, the competitors concerned will each receive the points for this position i.e. Competitor A -20 points; Competitor B -20 points and Competitor C-15 points.

5. Title

The title of "ACU Eastern Youth Enduro Champion" will be awarded to the best overall performance by a Youth Rider competing in the separate Youth Race.

6. Calculation of championship positions

At the conclusion of the series, the winner and the overall title of "ACU Youth Eastern Enduro Champion" will be determined as follows:

- a) 4 rounds all to count.
- b) More than 4 rounds one event to be dropped.
- c) If the calculation of points in accordance with clause 8(a) subsequently results in a tie the following will take precedence:
 - Driver with the highest number of first places
 - Driver with the highest number of second places etc.

7. Awards

Awards to be presented to the top 3 youth riders.

The ACU Eastern Annual Youth Trophy will be awarded to the individual champion and may be held by the youth champion until requested for return by the ACU Eastern. The award cannot be won outright. ACU Eastern may require a written undertaking to return the trophy when requested. Replicas, for permanent keepsake will be given to the Champion. Should the individual champion not be resident within the ACU Eastern boundaries, the trophy will be engraved with the name of that Champion and may be presented to the winner at the ACU Eastern Function. However, the trophy will be returned immediately that evening to the Centre for safe keeping as it will not be permitted to leave the ACU Eastern boundary.

8. Refusal of entry

If requested by an organising club, or if they consider it appropriate in the best interests of the sport, the ACU Eastern Competitions Committee may, at their discretion, declare any rider ineligible to compete in any ACU Eastern Championship event (of any discipline) where the rider has been the subject of a formal disciplinary enquiry by any part of the ACU and had their competition licence withdrawn for a period of at least six months and/or fined more than £500.
